


done with them.

Toss candy wrappers into the trash.

They're not recyclable.

Batteries – including the ones inside musical cards – are not recyclable. Dispose of them safely by checking battery drop-off locations in your area. But many Valentine's items are able to be picked up in your curbside recycling cart including greeting cards, wrapping paper, gift bags, tissue paper and cardboard boxes.

Items like candy boxes, cellophane, ribbons and bows, bubble wrap and foam peanuts should go in the trash if you cannot reuse them.

Once flowers wilt, put them into your organics cart, your compost bin or out with the trash.
