

Recycling

Accepted in Recycling Cart

General Guidelines

- Recycling pickup occurs on trash day, every other week. Place carts out by 7 a.m. For collection schedule, visit [RepublicServices.com/schedule](https://www.republicservices.com/schedule).
- Residents may choose a 48-, 65- or 95-gallon comingled recycling cart. All materials must fit in the cart with the lid closed.

Glass Recycling Drop Site

- Residents may drop off glass at the Republic Services site, 3015 E. Comstock Ave., Nampa, ID. Site is open to the public 8 a.m. – 5 p.m., Mon. – Fri.
- **Accepted:** rinsed bottles and jars. Remove corks and lids. Labels are OK.
- **Not Accepted:** mirrors, windows, Pyrex, dishes, fish tanks, lights, ceramics, cardboard or plastic bags.

Yard Waste Collection

- Cut tree limbs, hedge trimmings, or other wood waste into sections less than 4 feet. Tie bundles 18 inches or less in diameter and set out in compact piles weighing 30 lbs. or less.
- Contain grass clippings, leaves and other debris in your cart or trash can weighing 30 lbs. or less. Please no sod, dirt, or rocks.



Please make sure recyclables are loose in cart.

No plastic bags



Plastic – #1 and #2

Soda and juice bottles, lotion, shampoo and soap bottles, and milk jugs (*empty, rinse, replace caps*)



Metal Containers

Food and beverage cans, aluminum foil and trays, metal lids larger than 3 inches (*empty, rinse, do not crush*)



Paper

Envelopes (cellophane window OK), junk mail, magazines, catalogs, office paper, and paper bags



Cardboard

Empty and flatten cardboard boxes, paperboard food boxes, shoe and gift boxes, and pizza boxes (*food removed and not saturated with grease*)

Residential Rates in Middleton Are Determined by Cart Size

Three cart sizes are available: 48-gallon (limited to cart only), 65-gallon (limited to cart only) and 95-gallon (cart plus cans).

All waste must be placed in the 48- and 65-gallon carts with limited service.

95-gallon cart customers must fill their cart before placing additional waste in 32-gallon trash cans for collection.

Customer's monthly rate is based on the size of trash cart.

Extra carts are available for a small monthly fee.

Senior and Veteran Discounts

- Middleton offers a discounted monthly fee to seniors (65 and older) and U.S. military veterans.

Carry-Out Service

Customers who qualify under the Americans with Disabilities Act may receive free carry-out service. Other customers may sign up for carry-out service for an extra monthly charge. To order carry-out service, call Republic Services at **208.345.1265**.

Bulk Waste and Appliances

- Republic Services provides appliance, furniture and other large item collection for an additional fee. Bulk items must be outside and visible to the driver. Contact Republic Services to arrange a special pickup at **208.345.1265**.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Quarterly Collection

- Residents in Canyon County may drop off household hazardous waste during designated collection days. Hazardous materials include (but are not limited to): fluorescent tubes, CFL bulbs, paint, stain, varnish, computer monitors, televisions, vehicle batteries, gasoline, oil, pesticides, and herbicides. For details on the HHW collection locations, please call **208.466.7288**. Collections will take place for one day in March, June, September, and December.

Spring Extra Trash Collection

- Free pickup of bulk items and non-Freon® appliances is available every year during Spring Cleanup Week in April. Refer to the annual service calendar for specific dates.
- You must call ahead to schedule bulk items and non-Freon® appliances waste service.
- Annual free trash day at the Canyon County Landfill is the 4th Saturday in April.
- Free curbside pickup of bulk items, non-Freon® appliances, tied wood bundles (4 ft. or shorter, 60 lbs. or less), large paper bags of yard debris, and extra trash in personal containers.



General Guidelines

- Carts must be out by 7 a.m. with the lids closed. Remove carts from curbside within 24 hours.
- Residents may choose a 48-, 65- or 95-gallon cart.
- All material must be inside cart. Items outside of cart except during Spring Cleanup Week or pre-scheduled collection will not be collected. Bag trash to prevent it from blowing away during service.
- Place carts 3 ft. from other carts and objects (mailboxes, fire hydrants, cars, utility poles) with the handle towards the house and wheels in the curb. Never block sidewalk access.
- Place used motor oil in clear 1-gallon jugs with a threaded neck. Make them visible to the driver on trash day (up to 2 gallons per week).



Prohibited Materials

- No explosives, ammunition, tires, liquids, radioactive items, non-alkaline batteries, biomedical or hazardous waste.
- DO NOT place loose sharps (needles, syringes, lancets) in carts.
