Make sure your recyclables are empty, clean and dry.

Paper



Newspaper, inserts, magazines, catalogs and phone books



Advertising mail, envelopes, mixed paper



Corrugated cardboard (3'x3' or smaller, flattened)



Paperback books (donate to Goodwill or local senior center)

Plastic

(only #1 and #2 bottleneck-style bottles and jugs)



Milk jugs (no lids)



Plastic bottles (no lids)



Plastic jugs

Glass

Glass is not collected curbside. Please bring your glass bottles and jars to the Grants Pass Recycling Depot at 1920 NW Washington Blvd.



Bottles and jars (empty and rinse; labels OK)

Metal

(loose in bins; no bags)



Aluminum, aluminum tins and metal cans (empty, clean and dry)

Cart Color: Brown | **Cart Size:** 64-gallon

How to prepare your recyclables:

- All containers, bottles, cans and jars should be empty, clean and dry
- All recycling should go into the recycling cart
- No food waste, liquid or plastic bags
- Do NOT bag or box recyclables; leave loose
- All recyclables should fit in your recycling cart with the lid closed (if you have large cardboard, bring it to our Recycling Depot)

Set carts out by 4 a.m. Set carts out with handles toward the house. Do not block cars, bike lanes, mailboxes, sidewalks or driveways. Remove carts as soon as possible after collection.

Holidays - No collection on New Year's Day or Christmas Day. If collection falls mid-week on a holiday, it will shift one day the rest of that week.

Recycling - Picked up every other week.

Spring Recycling Event: Earth Day/Tire Take-Back Day at Merlin Transfer Station (1749 Merlin Road, Grants Pass, OR 97526) April 19 (8 a.m. – 3 p.m.)

Household Hazardous Waste Event - To be determined at a later date. Check our local website for the most updated calendar of events.

Christmas Tree Drop-Off - Friday, December 26, 2025 - Friday, January 16, 2026.

Residents can bring their bare, unflocked Christmas trees to the recycling center at the Grants Pass office or to the transfer station free of charge.
