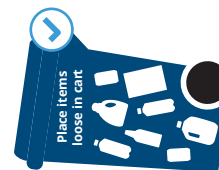

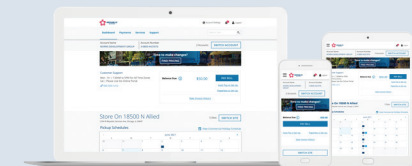

**NO** SHREDDED PAPER

**NO** PLASTIC BAGS, FILM OR WRAPPERS

✓ Keep dry



## Cardboard & Poly-Coated Cartons

- ✓ Flatten boxes
- ✓ 3 ft. x 3 ft. x 3 ft. max.
- ✓ Keep dry



## Metal Containers

✓ Empty, clean and dry



## Glass Bottles & Jars

- ✓ Empty, clean and dry
- ✓ Unbroken
- No lids



## Plastics

- ✓ Empty, clean and dry
- ✓ Recycle by shape – tubs, bottles and jugs



## Food Scraps & Yard Waste

✓ Cedar Grove-approved compostable bags are OK

**NO** SHREDDED PAPER

**NO** PLASTIC BAGS, FILM OR WRAPPERS

**NO** ROCKS, DIRT, BARK OR PET WASTE



Max. 60 lbs.

## Plants & Yard Waste

✓ Branches 4 ft. max



## Fruits & Vegetables

No stickers



## Meat, Bones & Leftovers



## Dairy, Eggs & Bread



## Food-Soiled Paper

✓ Un-coated (no shiny paper)
