

Recycling Regulations

Recycling Law (AB341):

A business (includes public entities) that generates 4 cubic yards or more of commercial waste per week or is a multifamily residential dwelling of five units or more shall arrange for recycling services.

Organics Law (AB1826):

A business (includes public entities) that generates 2 cubic yards or more of commercial waste per week or is a multifamily residential dwelling of five units or more shall arrange for organic services.

State Bill 1383 (SB1383):

Requires all residents, schools, businesses (includes public entities), and apartments to arrange for organic services.

Hazardous Waste

Household hazardous waste is a material that cannot be placed in the organics, recycling or trash cart. These materials should be disposed of safely and properly.

Helpful Tips!

- ▶ Place all items in the recycling cart in an empty, clean, and dry state.
- ▶ All recyclable and organic products must be disposed of loosely inside your recycling/organic cart; no plastic bags.
- ▶ To ensure a safe pickup of your bin/cart, do not overload your cart. The lid must be able to close.

Reglamentaciones en materia de reciclaje

Ley de reciclaje (AB341):

A business (includes public entities) that generates 4 cubic yards or more of commercial waste per week or is a multifamily residential dwelling of five units or more shall arrange for recycling services.

Ley de residuos orgánicos (AB1826):

Una empresa (incluidas las entidades públicas) que genera dos yardas cúbicas (2 yd³ o 1.5 m³) o más de residuos comerciales por semana, o bien, una vivienda residencial multifamiliar de cinco unidades o más deberá contar con servicios de recolección de residuos orgánicos.

La ley del estado 1383 (SB1383):

obliga a todos los residentes, escuelas, empresas (incluidas entidades públicas) y apartamentos a organizar la recogida de residuos orgánicos.



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Residuos peligrosos

Los residuos domésticos peligrosos son materiales que no se pueden colocar en el contenedor de residuos orgánicos, de reciclaje o de basura. Estos materiales deben eliminarse de manera segura y adecuada.

- ▶ Anticongelante
- ▶ Productos para automóviles
- ▶ Productos de limpieza
- ▶ Pesticidas y herbicidas
- ▶ Lámparas fluorescentes
- ▶ Aceite y látex
- ▶ Medicamentos recetados
- ▶ Baterías
- ▶ Agujas
- ▶ Pintura

¡Solo un consejo!

- ▶ Coloque todos los artículos vacíos, limpios y secos en el contenedor de reciclaje.
- ▶ Todos los productos orgánicos y reciclables deben colocarse sueltos dentro de su contenedor de reciclaje o de residuos orgánicos, no los coloque en bolsas de plástico.
- ▶ Para garantizar que la recolección del contenedor o cubo se realice en forma segura, no sobrecargue el contenedor. La tapa debe poder cerrarse.
