Compost Giveaway

Republic Services and the City of Clovis will host the annual Compost Giveaway Event on March 1, 2025, from 7 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Clovis residents can come by 810 Nees Ave. and receive up to 3 yards of FREE compost. Residents must bring proof of residency, such as a copy of your utility bill, and the compost ticket included with your bill.

Compost is in bulk form. You must provide your own container to transport the compost. No bags or containers will be made available. Trucks with racks will be directed to the self-loading area.

Clovis Yard Sale

Clovis residents have the opportunity to participate in the City's annual Citywide Yard Sale the weekend of April 12 and 13. Beginning March 1 and through April 13, the last day of the sale, sellers can register for the yard sale and list their available items.


Overloaded Carts

Carts should be off the curb, 3 feet apart from each other, and placed 6 feet away from vehicles or other objects.

Do not overload your cart. **LIDS MUST BE CLOSED.** Tightly packed green waste and recycling can become lodged in the cart. This prevents material from being dumped during service.

RECYCLE TIP: Cut down large cardboard pieces, and flatten boxes before placing them in your blue cart. Cut down large branches and stems before placing them in your green cart.

Recycle Leftover Paint with PaintCare

PaintCare, the nonprofit stewardship program created by the paint industry, provides sites in Clovis where residents can recycle unwanted paint, stain, and varnish all year-round.

Find a drop-off location near you by visiting Paintcare.org/drop-off-sites. All sites accept up to 5 gallons per visit. Please call ahead to confirm business hours and ask whether the type and amount of paint you would like to recycle is accepted. Sites do not accept spray paint or leaking, unlabeled, or empty containers.

Households with 100 gallons or more can request a free large-volume pickup. Visit Paintcare.org/pickup to learn more and request a pickup.
