Holiday Tree Recycling: January 6 - January 17, 2025

From January 6 to January 17, 2025, Republic Services will collect natural Christmas trees for free. Please remove any flocking, decorations and tree stands. You can either place your tree curbside for pickup, or cut it into 2-foot sections, and place in your organics cart, along with any natural holiday wreaths and greenery. The wreaths and greenery must also be bare. Please remove all wire, hooks, bows, and other decorations.

If your family enjoys an artificial tree, pack it up for next year. If you are discarding an artificial tree or wreath, please place it in your gray trash cart.


Did You Know?
