How to avoid overage and contamination fees

Per the organic facility: **compost bags and plastic bags are NOT acceptable**



- Break down, and flatten boxes.
- Make sure lids are fully closed.
- Do not bag items in plastic bags.
- No electronics, furniture, fabrics, shoes, construction materials, hazardous waste, oil, pet waste, or Styrofoam™.

Organics Container

Acceptable items: grass, leaves, branches, flowers, food waste, table food scraps and food-soiled paper products. Paper brown bags without wax film or ink can be used with food waste.



Not acceptable: plastic bags, plastic wrap (including certified compostable items), recyclables including clean cardboard, raw meat, construction waste, pet waste, trash, fat, oil, grease, and hazardous waste

Recycling Container

Acceptable items: plastics (#1-#7), paper food containers, metal cans, aluminum foil, cardboard, paper, glass bottles and jars.



Not acceptable: flexible plastics, fabric, shoes, construction waste, hazardous waste, polystyrene foam, and organic waste.
