Place your food waste in your organics cart! Fruit peels, pits and seeds, cooked meat and bones, and other food scraps are all accepted.



Keep trash out of your organics cart. Garden hoses, outdoor furniture, pet waste and all other trash should not be placed in your organics cart.



Make sure to properly dispose of your recycling, trash and organic waste in the proper carts. For bulk items, call us at **831.775.3840** to schedule your once-yearly FREE pickup. Please do not litter or illegally dump bulk items.

Safety is our priority. Improper disposal can cause fires inside our trucks, as well as at the landfill. Join us in keeping our community safe by remembering the following.



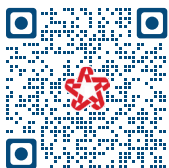
Batteries of any kind should not be disposed of curbside. Bring your batteries to any of the Salinas public libraries for free disposal.



Please keep hot coals and ashes out of your carts. Coals should be completely cooled before disposal. Once they have cooled for several days, they can be safely disposed of in your trash cart.



Household hazardous waste (HHW) should never be thrown away in your curbside carts. This includes paint, sharps, electronic waste, pharmaceuticals, cleaners and other chemicals. Salinas Valley Recycles accepts HHW from Salinas residents for FREE at 1104 Madison Lane, Salinas.
