Composting Required by State and Local Laws

All Union City household must have compost collection service per State and local laws*, even if they don't produce yard trimmings, as food scraps must be separated for composting. When food scraps, food-soiled paper and yard trimmings are buried in landfills, they produce greenhouse gas emissions as they decompose. By composting the right items in the green compost cart, you will help Union City:

- · Conserve landfill space
- · Reduce greenhouse gas emissions
- · Comply with State and local laws*
- Create compost, a valuable soil amendment that saves water and nourishes plants and trees

Let's work together to keep Union City green!
