



Reducing Single-Use Foodware Accessories and Condiments

The State of California (AB 1276) requires all retail food facilities **and** food delivery platforms to provide single-use foodware items upon request *only*.

Under the Law:

- Single-use foodware items, including self-service items, cannot be bundled or packaged in a way that prevents a consumer from taking only the item needed.
- A food facility using a third-party delivery platform must list on its menu the availability of single-use items and condiments, and provide those items only when requested.

Customer-Provided Reusables

California State Law AB 619 allows customers to bring their own clean, reusable food and beverage containers for takeout orders and leftovers. Following all sanitary guidelines, reusable containers are safe for employees, customers and the environment.

Single-use foodware items include those made from plastic, biodegradable plastic and wood.
