SB 1383 Enforcement is Now in Effect

California's Short-lived Climate Pollutant Reduction Law, also known as SB 1383, aims to reduce emissions of methane from food and organic waste in landfills by requiring businesses to subscribe to Wet (organic) service and sort organic waste separately.

Enforcement is now in effect and City of San José staff are visiting businesses to ensure compliance. Make sure you know what is needed at your business to be in compliance. Visit SJEnvironment.org/SB1383 to learn more.



Get FREE Indoor Wet Receptacles for Your Business

The City of San José's Wet Receptacle Assistance Program ("WRAP") helps San José businesses comply with Senate Bill 1383 by providing free indoor receptacles to collect and properly sort organic waste, also known as Wet waste. Approved businesses can select up to \$500 worth of indoor receptacles and equipment at no cost.
