- ✓ Labels OK
- Remove metal lids

Recycle Right!

- Plastic bags are not recyclable at at the Recycling Center. Please recycle them at participating grocery stores.
- X Rigid plastic clamshells and hard plastics from produce or bakery items are not acceptable at the Recycling Center. Please dispose of these as trash.
- X Polystyrene (Styrofoam™) and packing peanuts are not recyclable, but many mailing services will accept clean, bagged polystyrene.
- Batteries may NEVER be placed in your trash or recycling carts. Dispose of batteries at transfer stations.
- × NEVER put your recycling in plastic bags.

Motor Oil, Pesticides and Batteries

- X Bottles or jugs used to contain motor oil, pesticides, herbicides or other hazardous materials may NOT be recycled.
