- ✓ Magazines
- ✓ Junk mail
- ✓ Catalogs
- ✓ Phone books
- ✓ Paper
- ✓ Paper bags
- ✓ Mixed paper
- ✓ Envelopes
- ✓ Shredded strips of paper
- ✓ Newspaper
- ✓ Wrapping paper
- ✓ Flattened corrugated cardboard
- ✓ Cereal, cracker, soda and beer cartons
- ✓ Paper egg cartons

Plastic

- ✓ Plastic bottles
- ✓ Tubs 6 oz. and larger (lids on)
- ✓ Rigid plastic containers
- ✓ Yogurt and margarine tubs
- ✓ Rigid plastic plant pots (4" or larger)
- ✓ Plastic buckets (5 gallons or less)
- ✓ Plastic milk jugs



Tin & Aluminum

- ✓ Cans (labels OK)
- ✓ Foil, pie tins
- ✓ Metal trays
- ✓ Beverage cans



Glass

- ✓ Labels OK
- ✓ Remove metal lids

Recycle Right!

- ✗ Plastic bags are not recyclable at Recycle Depot. Please recycle them at participating grocery stores.
- ✗ Rigid plastic clamshells and hard plastics from produce or bakery items are not acceptable at Recycle Depot. Please dispose of these as trash.
- ✗ Polystyrene (styrofoam™) and packing peanuts are not recyclable, but many mailing services will accept clean, bagged polystyrene.
- ✗ Batteries may NEVER be placed in your trash or recycling carts. Dispose of batteries at transfer stations.
- ✗ NEVER put your recycling in plastic bags.

NOT ACCEPTED:

Motor Oil, Pesticides and Batteries

- ✗ Bottles or jugs used to contain motor oil, pesticides, herbicides or other hazardous materials may NOT be recycled.
- ✗ Batteries are not accepted at the La Pine Depot. Please take these materials to the Deschutes County Landfill or Transfer Station.
