Prohibited Materials





The following items CANNOT go in a dumpster.



- Hazardous waste
- Liquid waste (this includes paint, motor oil, etc.)
- Vehicles
- Lead-acid and lithium-ion batteries
- Tires

- Electronics (covered electronic devices: computers, DVDs, VCRs, TVs, etc.)
- Recyclables (appliances and source-separated materials prepared for recycling, unless the material load is deemed contaminated and can no longer be recycled)
- Asbestos-containing materials (the exception to this would be if the load was friable asbestos, was properly packaged and secured as required by regulations, was accompanied by an ASN-4 form, and was disposed of in the asbestos area of the landfill)

Loads that are found to have these items are considered a mixed load and are subject to a higher tipping fee, plus additional fees, should they apply. For instance, the landfill has specific fees for appliances and tires, and those fees will be added onto the mixed load weight fee.
