

Bellevue Residential Rates - effective January 1, 2025

Effective January 1, 2025, Republic Services' solid waste rates in the City of Bellevue will increase to reflect Consumer Price Index (CPI) adjustments and a King County landfill disposal increase. All garbage rates include unlimited recycling and one 96-gallon compost cart plus up to three additional units of 32-gallons of compost each week. Rates are subject to applicable taxes and the King County Hazardous Waste Fee.

Note: Cart lids must be fully closed. If cart lids are not fully closed additional charges will occur.

Extra Recycling	No charge	Extras may be placed in a box, paper bags or extra can. Label "recycling" and place next to recycling cart.
Composting (yard debris and food scraps)		
One 96-gallon cart (default) plus up to 3-32 gallon units of extra yard debris in paper bags or customer owned can labeled "Yard Debris".	Included	No plastic bags. Only Cedar Grove approved compostable bags.
Extra 96-gallon cart rental fee (per month)	\$3.60	
Extra (more than 1 cart plus 3 - 32 gallon units) per week, per 32 gallons*	\$6.75	Extras may be placed in Kraft paper bags or extra can and cannot exceed 32 gallons or 55 lbs. Label

*Note: Yard debris refers to leaves, grass, and clippings of smaller branches. No rocks, dirt or treated wood. Branches may be set next to the cart with a maximum size of four (4) inches in diameter and/or four (4) feet in length and must be bundled with degradable (no nylon or synthetic) twine. Extras yard debris in paper bags or can may not weigh more than 55 lbs. No food waste outside of Republic Services cart.

Bulky waste – large appliances, furniture, large televisions, mattresses.	\$128.64	*not eligible for drop-off. Call to schedule pick-up: 425.452.4762
Fluorescent tubes and bulbs	Included	Wrap in newspaper and secure with tape. Drop-off or Call to schedule pick-up. Place next to recycling cart and mark "fluorescent tubes." Size limit: no longer than 4 ft. Limit 2 tubes/bulbs per collection. Limit 10 tubes/bulbs per year.
Household batteries (alkaline, button and rechargeable)	Included	Place rechargeable and non-rechargeable batteries in separate, clear, sealed bags. Drop-off or Call for scheduled pick-up. Set on top of recycling cart.
Rigid plastics (clean 5 gallon buckets, PVC pipe, laundry baskets, plastic lawn furniture, Big Wheels, storage tubs and reusable plastic water bottles)	Included	Place items in cart or next to recycling cart. One dimension of the object must be less than 2 ft. For larger items, drop-off or Call to schedule pick-up: 425.452.4762
Scrap metal	Included	All ferrous and non-ferrous scrap metal, including lids larger than 3" that is free of wood, plastic, rubber and any other contaminants may be placed in the cart. Drop-off at Republic Services or Call to schedule pick-up of larger items.
Small appliances (microwave ovens, toaster ovens, irons)	Included	Limit 2 ft x2 ft x2 ft or smaller and less than 60 lbs. Call to schedule pick-up: 425.452.4762 Set on top of or next to recycling cart on specified day.
Small electronics (computer equipment, audio equipment TVs, cell phones, MP3 players)	Included	Limit 2 ft x2 ft x2 ft or smaller and less than 60 lbs. Call to schedule pick-up: 425.452.4762 Place in clear plastic bag. Set on top of or next to recycling cart on specified day.
Textiles	Included	Call to schedule pick-up: 425.452.4762 Place clean, dry clothing and household textiles in clear plastic bag and place on or next to recycling cart on specified day.
Styrofoam ® (white, block form)	Included	Drop off only. Do not place in recycling cart. Drop-off at Republic Services. Must be broke down to pieces maximum 2ft x 2ft.
Used cooking oil (FOG – fats, oil, grease)	Included	Limit 3 gallons per drop-off or pick-up. Limit 10 total gallons per year. Seal uncontaminated oil (no large solids) in clean, clear, screw-top plastic jugs. Label jugs with name and address. Place next to recycling container. Call to schedule pick-up: 425.452.4762
